Club President Troy Peterson gave the results of the recent Costa Mesa Fish Fry in which HSS maintained a booth. Troy said that although activity was quite slow initially, things began to pick up around two P.M. Troy's conclusion was that it was a good community relations event for HSS but that because things got off to a late start, we should have stayed later.

A motion was made and approved for a committee to explore the feasibility of approaching the city to set up some form of regulations and means of enforcement in an effort to prevent the very real possibility of a serious accident.

MINUTES OF SPECIAL COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON JULY 15, 2004

Meeting was called to order with 11 committee members present.

Each member, in turn, gave his views as to how we might approach the city in an effort to set up regulations for our flying field.

It was agreed to contact Mike Long who, as a member of the Laguna Niguel Soaring Society, set up general guidelines and gained the city's approval and support. Mike will be asked to attend the September HSS meeting and give us his input.

Fred Hesse pointed out that AMA gives assistance with "site preservation". Bill Eckles agreed to contact AMA in this regard.

It was determined that if we provided a "charging station" at our storage container, it might help to keep the non-member electric fliers away from the homes and parking area.

Jim Parsons agreed to provide help with the design and installation of such a station.

A motion was made and denied to provide a Porta-Pottie at the upcoming SC Square event.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:45 P.M.


August 3rd Meeting Notice
