Dollar Tree Foam Challenge

Event Description:

HSS is planning a fun competition to design, build, and fly an original electric powered model of your choice. This event was first proposed by Kevin Koch in 2017. This year's event to be held at Fairview Model Airport on October 13, 2018. Design rules, construction guidelines, and flight demonstration requirements are shown below. Have fun!.

Potential Participants:

Most of electric flying HSS members and non-member guests. Entrants must have AMA membership and City of Costa Mesa flying permit.

Previous Event:

First event was held 31 October, 2017, at Fairview Park. It was flown in two sessions, 8 to 11 AM, and 2 to 6 PM.

Results:

Awards and photos are shown in December 2017 Plane Rap newsletter.

First Place: Kevin Koch \$50 Gift Certificate
Second Place: Bill Sharkey \$30 Gift Certificate
Third Place: Larry Koch \$20 Gift Certificate

Rules:

Initial rules are shown on attached flyer. These were modified to allow use of two sheets of foam for 2017 only.

In an initial burst of enthusiasm, rules were suggested at the May 1st 2018 General Meeting. A draft version is shown below. These rules supersede any conflicting rules shown in flyer.

- 1. Event shall be held on Saturday October 13, 2018.
- 2. Two sessions will be held. 7:30 to 9:30 AM, and 4 PM to sunset.
- 3. Battery is limited to 3 cells in series. Capacity is unlimited.
- 4. Pilot will fly two complete circles of the flying field. (Boundaries to be posted?).
- 5. Flying ability (stability) to be assessed by judges.
- Spot landing shall be attempted, and measured. Point of landing to be determined.
- 7. Score is total of two best flights. Number of attempts to be determined.
- 8. Maximum weight is 300 Gms (10.6 oz).
- 9. Construction is limited to one sheet of foam, as specified in flyer.
- 10. Plywood firewall is allowed. Spars and other structural parts may be of any material.
- 11. One stunt to be performed such as loop or roll, to be called out by pilot while flying.
- 12. Design to be shown at Fairview Park flying field prior to the event.
- 13. A points scale will be prepared for judging the following characteristics. Note that Joni Whitsitt might be able to provide the points grading that she used in 2017.

Design originality.

Craftsmanship.

Stability of flight while circling field.

Stunt quality.

Spot landing (Quality and measurement to landing spot).

2018 DOLLAR TREE FOAM CHALLENGE

Date: Saturday October 13, 2018, Fairview Model Airport

Time: 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM (1st session)

4:00 PM to 6:00 PM (2nd session)

The main thrust of the Challenge is to use one "Dollar Tree Foam Sheet" for the structure of the airplane. It's your choice to use any design, <u>any weight under 300 grams (10.6 Oz) and any electric source of power.</u> Radio control is implied by the flight tasks.

If you think the Challenge is too difficult you should Google "Nutballrc". The plane is built from <u>one sheet</u> of "Dollar Tree" foam and a hot glue gun or epoxy. Additional structural support is of your choice.

We are doing the Challenge in two sessions to give the membership plenty of time to attend. No Landing Fee. AMA membership and City of Costa Mesa flying permit required.


- 1. Design and Appearance
- 2, Craftsmanship
- 3. Fly ability (stable fly by) during 720 degree (2 overlapping circles)
- 4. Perform aerobatic stunt (loop or role called out by pilot).
- 5. Controlled spot landing, measured to target.





2018 City Flying Permits Available

A permit to fly radio-controlled model aircraft is required to operate model aircraft at Fairview Park. This permit can be obtained by going to www.costmesaca.gov and downloading the file Model Airplane Fly Permit 2014.pdf You must also show proof of adequate liability insurance in the form of a current Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) membership card or a current homeowners/personal liability policy specifically covering model aircraft operation with a minimum limit of \$500,000. Rules and regulations for flying the model aircraft can be found in the City of Costa Mesa Municipal Code, Title 12, Chapter II, Articles 2 & 3.

Permit Fee: \$50 per year for Costa Mesa residents. \$55 for nonresidents, plus \$5 Administration fee.. Learner's Permit for youths 6-14 years old - \$TBD per year.

Renewal Packet must include **ALL** of the following:

- Permit Application (filled out and signed).
- Copy of your driver's license.
- Copy of the AMA Membership Card (showing the required year) or home owner's/personal liability insurance policy (specifically covering model airplane/aircraft flying with a minimum limit of \$500,000).
- Renewal Fee payment by Check (payable to <u>City of Costa Mesa</u>) or charge to Credit Card (filled out and signed).

Note: Current permit holders with email addresses on file with the City will receive renewal packet via email. If you have questions or need additional information, please call the Recreation Division at (714) 754-5300.

Note that to fly at Fairview Park you need the above permit, liability insurance (preferably AMA), and you need to follow City of Costa Mesa Ordinance No. 07-01, City Regulations for Issuance, Suspension and Revocation of Permits to Fly at Fairview Park, Academy of Model Aeronautics Safety Code, and the Fairview Park Flying rules posted at the flying site.


